Nairobi Excursions

OS 001 Bomas of Kenya “Boma” is a Swahili word meaning homestead, there are several Bomas(villages) of different ethnic tribes built using traditional specifications in the compound, here you will learn more about the Kenyan tribes, their culture and amazing dance performances of different ethnic groups in the auditorium.

OS 002 African heritage is a striking building sitting on a hill overlooking the Nairobi National Park which was built in a combination of mud architectures from across Africa that houses over 6,000 rare and precious items collected over half a century.

OS 003 Giraffe Center is an environmental conservation center located in Langata, it is home of the Rothschild Giraffe. Here you get to see the giraffes living in a semi-wild state, learn about their behaviors, traits and conservation efforts. One can also get the opportunity to feed these gentle giants from a raised observation platform.

OS 004 David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust operates as an elephant rescue and rehabilitation program, here one can take a walk through the center where baby elephants wait to be fed. Watch them play in the water, gargle their milk, and discover each elephant's personal stories. Once the youngest is fed, it's time to feed the 2-3-year-olds, some of whom are old enough to feed themselves. Watch as they hold their giant milk bottles in their trunks and make quick work of several gallons of milk.

OS 005 Kazuri Beads Factory “kazuri” a Swahili word meaning small and beautiful began in 1975 as an experimenting workshop of handmade beads. At kazuri one gets the opportunity to admire the beautiful beads and pottery which have been handcrafted by African women.



OS 006 Nairobi National Museum is Located on Museum Hill, the museum showcases Kenya's rich Heritage with four distinct themes representing Kenya's Culture, Nature, History and Contemporary Art, while there one can also visit the Snake Park since it is within the compound.

OS 007 Nairobi gallery is located at Kenyatta avenue and Uhuru highway in Nairobi city. It was built in 1913 to house the native ministry. Now it serves as museum which promote artists through display of their art work and temporary art exhibitions for both pioneer and upcoming artists.



OS 008 Nairobi National Park This is the only National Park that is found in the City in the whole world. It is located 7 km from the capital City Nairobi. In the park you'll get to see wild animals and Nairobi city buildings from far. Nairobi National Park has a **Safari Walk** which is well-designed with elevated wooden boardwalk passing through parts of the park where you get close to the wild animals roaming in the park and get a glimpse of what to expect during your safaris or touring Kenya. There are also over 2000 different species of trees that are in the safari walk. Nairobi National Park also has an **Animal Orphanage** which serves as a rehabilitation center of animals. The experience of visiting Nairobi Animal Orphanage is one of a kind. It is exciting to interact close-up with the wildlife and also knowing that these animals are survivors. Each of the animals in the orphanage has been taken by park rangers and been provided with medical treatment. Observing animals at the orphanage is different and not as majestic as spotting them roaming in the wild in healthy conditions.

OS 009 Karen Blixen Museum is a beautiful farmhouse located just 10km outside Nairobi city, it was home of Karen Blixen author of "Out of Africa" who lived between 1914- 1931, here you'll get comprehensive insight into the person of Karen Blixen. The farmhouse is surrounded by a tranquil garden where you can get to enjoy sightseeing of Ngong Hills since it is located at the hills foot.



Nairobi Short Trips

OS 010 Masai Mara by Road (2 nights)

Departs daily from Nairobi from 0800hrs

Day 1 Nairobi – Masai Mara.

Depart Nairobi in the morning at around 0800hrs for a journey south through the floor of the Great Rift Valley. Arrive for Lunch at the camp/Lodge. Enjoy late afternoon game viewing. Dinner and overnight at the camp/Lodge

Day 2 Masai Mara Full day.

Full day in the park in search of the Big Five. Meals and overnight at campsite/lodge

Day 3 Masai Mara – Nairobi.

Morning breakfast, Morning game drive or Optional visit to Masai Village, depart Mara for Nairobi, stop for lunch (paid for by guests) arriving Nairobi late afternoon. App 1600hrs

OS 011 Lake Nakuru & Masai Mara (3nights)

Departs daily from Nairobi at 0900hrs.

Day 1 Nairobi - Lake Nakuru National Park.

Depart and drive to Lake Nakuru National Park. Lunch at the Lodge followed by afternoon game viewing drive. Dinner and overnight stay at the lodge.

Day 2 Lake Nakuru National Park-Masai Mara Game Reserve.

Depart after breakfast and drive to the Masai Mara game reserve arriving in time for lunch. Afternoon game viewing drive. Dinner and overnight stay at the lodge/camp

Day 3 Masai Mara Full day.

Full day in the park in search of the Big Five. Meals and overnight at campsite/lodge

Day 4 Masai Mara -Nairobi.

Morning breakfast, Morning game drive or Optional visit to Masai Village, depart Mara for Nairobi, stop for lunch (paid for by guests) arriving Nairobi late afternoon. App 1600hrs

OS 012 Ol pejeta Conservancy & Aberdare (2 nights)

Departs daily from Nairobi from 0800hrs

Day 1 Nairobi – Ol pejeta.

Depart Nairobi early morning for a journey North through the central Kenya highlands. Arrive for lunch at Serena Sweet waters camp whereby you'll be watching the animals as they come to quench their thirst at the waterhole just in front of the camp. After lunch visit the Chimpanzee Sanctuary, dinner and overnight at the camp.

Day 2 Ol pejeta-Aberdare

After breakfast, have a morning game drive en route to Aberdare National Park with views of Mt. Kenya, the country's highest peak. Arrive at the Lodge in time for lunch. As you relax, enjoy wildlife viewing from the balcony of your lodge in the afternoon and in the evening. Dinner & overnight at the lodge.

Day 3 Aberdare – Nairobi.

Have early morning game drive followed by optional nature walk to Karuru and Magura waterfalls, return to the lodge for Lunch before departing for Nairobi in the early afternoon.

OS 013 Amboseli by Road (2 nights)

Departs daily from Nairobi from 0700hrs

Day 1 Nairobi – Amboseli.

Depart Nairobi at 0700hrs and drive south across the Athi Plains, home of the Masai and on to Amboseli. arrive early mid-day and freshen up, followed by lunch and a short rest. You later explore the Amboseli plains in an evening game drive at 1600 hours.

Day 2 Amboseli Full day.

Rise early in this morning to catch view of Mt. Kilimanjaro. Full day in the park. Meals and overnight at the campsite/lodge.

Day 3 Amboseli – Nairobi.

You will wake for early morning game drive, back to the lodge for breakfast, depart Amboseli for Nairobi.

Nairobi Long Trips

OS 014 Samburu National Park/ Ol pejeta conservancy/ Lake Nakuru National Park/ Masai Mara National Reserve (6 Nights)

Day 1: Nairobi

Upon arrival you will be picked by Olanka Safaris representative at the Airport then drive to a hotel in Nairobi to refresh and relax after your long flight. You will also be briefed about your Kenya Safari. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 2: Nairobi-Samburu National Park

After breakfast, proceed to Samburu National Park arriving in time for lunch. After lunch enjoy a drive into the park to be met by animals such as Gerenuk (Giraffe gazelle), Grevy Zebra, reticulated Giraffe, Somali Ostrich, Eland and many others. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 3: Samburu National Park-Ol pejeta Conservancy

Early morning game drive that will provide you with an opportunity of seeing animals not usually encountered during the afternoon game drive such as spotted and striped hyena, mongoose, jackal, civet, genet and porcupine. Return to the camp/lodge for breakfast and check out for the drive to Ol pejeta. Proceed to Ol pejeta conservancy arriving in time for lunch and thereafter proceed for the afternoon game drive till late. This sanctuary is home to rehabilitated chimpanzees. This is one of the best places to see the big five of Africa which include lions, cape buffalo, savanna elephant, leopard and rhinos. Hundreds of other wildlife species roam the savannah plains and grasslands. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

Day 4: Ol Pejeta conservancy-Lake Nakuru National Park

After your breakfast, you will depart for Lake Nakuru National Park to arrive in time for check-in and lunch at the lodge. You will spend the mid-afternoon at leisure before going for an afternoon game drive around the lake until dusk when you return to the lodge.

The lake itself is a soda lake on the floor of the rift valley. The Lake has also earned a reputation as an important haven for endangered species- particularly the Rothschild Giraffe and the black and white rhino. Lion, leopard, waterbuck, buffalo, Columbus monkey, and baboons are all residents here.

Day 5: Lake Nakuru National Park-Masai Mara National Reserve

Enjoy breakfast then proceed to the Masai Mara National Reserve through the Great Rift Valley arriving in time for lunch. After lunch, spend mid-afternoon at leisure before going for an afternoon game drive until dusk when you return to your camp for dinner and overnight. This famous game reserve is world famous for the spectacular wildebeest migration between July through to September each year, the abundant wildlife including the 'Big five' of Africa. The reserve is surrounded by Masai villages (traditional home-steads).

Day 6: Masai Mara National Reserve

After breakfast, a full-day game drive in pursuit of the Big 5 and other wildlife that inhabits this park. Picnic boxes will be served at the designated picnic area near Mara River, thereafter proceed with an afternoon game drive. Returning to the camp for dinner and overnight.

Day 7: Masai Mara National Reserve-Nairobi

Rise up at first light and head for your last game drive in the reserve, returning to the lodge for breakfast which is a perfect way to cap off your visit to the Masai Mara National Reserve. You can also opt to visit the Masai village to learn about the Maa people's culture at extra cost. Depart for Nairobi with souvenir shopping along the way, arriving Nairobi in the afternoon. You will be taken to the airport to catch your flight back home.

Bird Watching



OS 015 Ol Pejeta Conservancy/ Lake Nakuru National Park/ Masai Mara National Reserve/ Nairobi National Park/ Amboseli National Park/ Tsavo West National Park/ Diani Beach/ Kisite Mpunguti Marine Park (13 Nights)

Day 01: JKIA Nairobi

Olanka Safaris guide driver will warmly meet you on arrival at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, transfer you to the Hotel. Check-in then will brief you on what will hopefully be your best holiday in Kenya East Africa. Enjoy overnight at the hotel. You are booked on Bed & Breakfast

Day 2: Nairobi – Ol Pejeta Conservancy

Enjoy breakfast then we proceed to the 90-hectare Ol Pejeta Conservancy, arriving at the Camp for check-in then lunch. Enjoy an afternoon game viewing drive. Enjoy dinner and overnight at the camp.

Day 3: Ol Pejeta- Lake Nakuru National Park

After your breakfast, you will depart for Lake Nakuru National Park to arrive in time for lunch. In the afternoon proceed for a game viewing drive. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 4: Lake Nakuru National Park – Masai Mara National Reserve

Enjoy breakfast then we proceed to the Masai Mara National Reserve arriving in time for lunch. Enjoy the lodge facilities before proceeding for afternoon game drive. Enjoy dinner and overnight at the Camp.

Day 5: Masai Mara National Reserve

Full day spend in Masai Mara in search of the Big Five. Meals and overnight at lodge.

Day 6: Masai Mara National park-Nairobi National Park

After breakfast, check out and depart Mara for the drive to Nairobi National Park arriving in time for lunch thereafter proceed for an afternoon game drive till late. Dinner and overnight at the lodge/camp in the park.

Day 7: Nairobi National park- Amboseli National Park

After breakfast, check out and depart Nairobi for the drive to Amboseli National Park arriving in time for lunch. Mid-afternoon will be for leisure enjoying the lodge's facilities before going for the afternoon game drive until dusk. Dinner and overnight at the lodge/camp in Amboseli.

Day 8: Amboseli National Park

Early morning game drive then return to the camp/lodge for breakfast, If the weather permits you will enjoy breath-taking views of the snow-capped Mount Kilimanjaro. It is from the Amboseli National Park where some of the most captivating wildlife photos with Mount Kilimanjaro in the background have been taken. Varied wildlife includes giraffes, zebras, elephants, cheetahs and hundreds of bird species. The western section is dominated by vast Lake Amboseli, which is dry outside the rainy season. Later return back to the Camp/ Lodge for dinner and overnight.

Day 9: Amboseli National Park-Tsavo West National Park

After breakfast depart for the Tsavo West National Park to arrive in time for check-in and lunch at the Lodge. Mid-afternoon will be at leisure enjoying the lodge's facilities before going for the afternoon game drive. At Tsavo West, you can see elephants, lions, hippos, giraffes, crocodiles, vervet monkeys, antelopes, baboons, and giraffes. The park is a marvel in terms of geo-physical character and plant diversity. In the afternoon you will get a chance to visit the Mzima Springs, the source of Mombasa's water located in this park.

These springs are recharged daily with hundreds of millions of liters of crystal-clear water by underground streams emanating from the Chyulu Hills. At Mzima, all sorts of animals gather for a drink, particularly in the dry season. You may also be able to view hippos and crocodiles from the underwater glass tank. Dinner and overnight at the Lodge/camp.

Day 10: Tsavo West National Park

After breakfast, check out with lunch boxes and proceed for a full-day game drive in pursuit of the Big 5 and other wildlife that inhabits this park. Picnic boxes will be served at the designated picnic site, thereafter proceed with an afternoon game drive. Returning to the camp for dinner and overnight.

Day 11: Tsavo West National Park- Diani Beach (South Coast)

Early morning game drive, back to the lodge for breakfast and check out Depart for the coastal part of Kenya where you will check-in at the resort for late lunch. The afternoon will be at our leisure exploring the beautiful beach. Dinner and overnight at the resort.

Day 12: Diani Beach- Wasini

Have an early breakfast then you will be picked for a full day Wasini and Kisite Mpunguti Marine Park excursion where you will spend the day enjoying the marine life. You will be able to spot the dolphins whilst you can swim with them. Snorkeling, Dhow ride, Wasini Island village walk, Shimoni slave cave tour are some of the day's activities that you will engage in. You will enjoy sea food lunch in between the activities. Return to Diani late afternoon to relax at the resort. Dinner and overnight at the resort.

Day 13: Diani Beach

You will spend this day at leisure at the beach resort enjoying the cool breezes of the beautiful Diani beach with optional water sports activities and Mombasa excursions (Bora Bora wildlife, Shiba hills, Fort Jesus & Haller Park at an extra cost. All meals will be served at the resort.

Day 14: Fly back to Nairobi to catch your flight back home

After early morning breakfast, you will be transferred to the Airport to take a domestic flight from Diani Nairobi, our driver will then transfer you to Jomo Kenyatta Airport where you will catch your international flight back home.



SGR SAFARIS

OS 016 Nairobi/ Tsavo/ Amboseli (2 nights)

Day 1: Nairobi- Tsavo West

After Breakfast Leave for Nairobi SGR station to arrive by 0700hrs. Depart at 0800hrs and arrive at Mtito Andei train terminal. Transfer to Kilaguni Serena Safari Lodge. After lunch have an afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

Day 2: Tsavo West- Amboseli

After breakfast check out and depart for Amboseli with en route game drive. Have lunch in Amboseli Serena Safari Lodge, proceed with an afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

Day 3: Amboseli

Transfer to Emali train station with an en route game drive.



OS 017 Nairobi/ Tsavo West /Mombasa (4 Nights)

Day 1: Nairobi- Tsavo

Depart to catch 0800hrs Madaraka Express train, alight at Voi train terminal. Transfer to Taita Hills Safari Resort to for lunch. Proceed with an afternoon game drive. Overnight at Salt Lick Safari Lodge, one of the most photographed lodges in the world. This Lodge provides a rare opportunity to view animals such as Elephant, Giraffe, Buffalo, Zebra, Antelopes among others at close proximity in their natural habitat.

Day 2: Tsavo

Have a morning game drive, afternoon at leisure/ afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 3: Mombasa

After breakfast, transfer to Voi train station to catch the train to Mombasa. Arriving early afternoon at the beach hotel. Spend the afternoon at leisure enjoying the beach and the hotel facilities. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 4: Mombasa

Have a city tour in Mombasa where you'll visit Haller park, Fort Jesus, have a walk in Old Town, visit different Curio shops, go to Mama Ngina Drive to see the sunset. Later on, you head back to the hotel for leisure. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

Day 5: Mombasa- Nairobi

After breakfast spend early morning at leisure, you'll later be transferred to Miritini SGR train terminal to catch the 1500hrs train to Nairobi.

OS 018 Masai Mara By Air (2 Nights)

Departs daily from Nairobi.

Day 1: Nairobi- Masai Mara

Depart for Masai Mara with a scheduled light air craft at Wilson Airport. On Arrival at Mara Airstrip you will be picked and transferred to the lodge /camp for check in and lunch. Later proceed for an afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight at lodge/ camp.

Day 2: Masai Mara

Leave for early morning game drive with packed breakfast and lunch for a full day game drive. Lunch to be served in the picnic site. Optional early morning Hot air balloon at an extra cost. Dinner and overnight at the hotel/ lodge.

Day 3: Masai Mara – Nairobi

Have a morning game drive, depart with a morning/ afternoon flight to Nairobi.

OS 019 Amboseli By Air (2 Night)

Departs daily from Nairobi

Day 1: Nairobi- Amboseli

Fly with a scheduled light air craft to Amboseli at the foot of Mt. Kilimanjaro, upon arrival you'll be transferred to lodge with en route game view. Enjoy your lunch and afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight at camp/lodge.

Day 2: Amboseli

Spend full day gaming at the park in pursuit to See the large herds of elephants that are found in the park. Also get a chance to see the crown of Mt. Kilimanjaro early in the morning when it is crystal clear. Afterwards head for lunch at the hotel. Afternoon game drive, dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 3: Amboseli- Nairobi

Check out After breakfast. Have a game drive en route to the air strip to fly back to Nairobi.

OS 020 Samburu By Air (2Nights)

Departs daily from Nairobi

Day 1: Nairobi – Samburu

Fly with a scheduled light air craft to Samburu National reserve. Enjoy lunch and an afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 2: Samburu

Morning and Afternoon game drives, dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 3: Samburu

Early morning game drive to observe the wildlife in Samburu. Late morning transfer to the air strip to catch your flight back to Nairobi.

OS 021 Malindi By Air (2 Nights)

Departs daily from Nairobi.

Day 1: Nairobi- Malindi

A scheduled flight, fly's you to Malindi where afterwards you are transferred to your hotel of choice. After Lunch spend early afternoon on leisure then leave for Malindi Marine Park where you'll get in a boat and sail away from the shores to where most fish gather, you'll swim along with the fish and also get to feed them. Later on, head back to the Hotel relax by the beach. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

Day 2: Malindi- Watamu

After breakfast we leave for Gede Ruins a historical and archaeological site which was once a city with a population of 2500 people and an approximate outer wall enclosing 45 acres which contained a Palace, Mosque and Numerous houses. Afterwards head to Watamu for Lunch then go to Watamu Marine National Park to get a chance to see the magnificent Dolphins and marine life. Overnight at the hotel in Malindi.

Day 3: Malindi- Nairobi

Early in the morning proceed for Vasco da Gama pillar a historical site which was built by the Portuguese explorers to give directions for those following the sea route to India. Afterwards transfer to Malindi Airport to catch flight back to Nairobi.

OS 022 Lamu By Air (2 Nights)

Departs daily from Nairobi.

Day 1: Nairobi- Lamu

A scheduled flight fly's you from Nairobi to Lamu island, an ancient Swahili town with no roads or vehicles with narrow maze-like streets that you can explore on a donkey or just take a walk. Here you'll get to explore the real Swahili culture. On arrival you will take at Manda airport a transfer by dhow takes you to the island of Lamu. After lunch spend the afternoon on leisure by the beach. Dinner and overnight at Hotel.

Day 2: Lamu

After breakfast start the day with a visit to Lamu town where you'll explore various sites such as Lamu fort, Lamu museum, Stone town, fish and vegetables market. In the afternoon visit Takwa ruins an ancient town that was abandoned when fresh water run out, it stands among the old crumbling stone ruins set between silent mangroves and the roaring open ocean. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 3: Lamu- Nairobi

After breakfast you can choose to relax at the sandy beaches of Lamu or take a tour to interact with the local people. Later you'll be transferred by boat to Manda Airport to catch your flight back to Nairobi



Mombasa Excursions

OS 023 Fort Jesus

Fort Jesus is located on Mombasa Island. The Fort, was built by the Portuguese in 1593- 1596 to the designs of Giovanni Battista Cairati to protect the port of Mombasa, is one of the most outstanding and well-preserved examples of 16th Portuguese military fortification and a landmark in the history of this type of construction. Fort Jesus Museum is symbolic of the history of the town of Mombasa.

OS 024 The Haller Park

Haller Park is a nature park in Bamburi, Mombasa, on the coast. It is the transformation of a quarry Wasteland into an ecological area. Haller Park holds a variety of plants and animal species which serve as a recreation spot for tourists and locals. It hosts a variety of wildlife including hippo, giraffe, buffaloes and antelopes, as well as smaller mammals and birds.

OS 025 Mombasa Marine Park & Reserve

The park lies between the Mtwapa and Tudor creeks and its blue waters are ideal for wind surfing, water skiing, snorkeling and diving. They also provide a room to a colorful variety of marine species, sea species and interesting migratory birds.



OS 026 Watamu

Watamu is a small coastal town in Kenya North of Mombasa. It's known for Marine national park and reserve which has 3 bays: Watamu, Blue Lagoon & Turtle. The marine park is considered one of the best snorkeling and diving areas on the coast of East Africa. It is also rated the third-best beach in Africa, for its crystal-clear water and silver sand beaches.



OS 027 Malindi

Malindi is a town on Malindi bay, in Southeastern Kenya. Malindi Marine National Park is home to Turtles and colorful fish. Arabuko-Sokoke Forest Reserve is home to more than 200 species of birds, Near the forest, the Gede Ruins are the remains of an ancient Swahili town. Malindi village is known for its wonderful Indian Ocean beaches.

MT. KENYA

Climbing to 5,199 meters, Mount Kenya is the second tallest mountain in Africa. The scenery surrounding this designated World Heritage Site is breath-taking. It is pristine wilderness with lakes, tarns, glaciers, dense forest, mineral springs and a selection of rare and endangered species of animals, high altitude adapted plains game and unique montane and alpine vegetation. Visitors can enjoy mountain climbing, camping and caving with the mountain's rugged glacier-clad peaks providing the perfect backdrop. The park is accessible via Nanyuki-Isiolo road via Sirimon Track, Nyeri-Nanyuki near Naromoru or Chogoria route. It is about 175 Kms from CBD Nairobi.

OS 028 Sirimon/Naromoru Route (4 Days)

Day 1: Nanyuki - Sirimon gate- Old Moses camp. (3,300m) 45 minutes, 9km walk, 680m ascent.

After pick up in Nairobi, drive to Nanyuki town crossing the equator en route to the Sirimon Park gate for lunch (2660m). From the gate, we trek up through magnificent montane forest, bamboo and giant heather zone before reaching the high-altitude moorland and our first hut (Old Moses camp 3,300m) for dinner and overnight. This is a gentle trek that takes 3 - 4 hrs gaining an elevation of 680m.

Day 2: Old Moses - Shipton camp (4200m). 7 hrs., 14km, 900m ascent.

After breakfast, follow the track uphill, forking right at the junction. After a water break, you continue on the track crossing Ontulili River before turning right contouring through the Moorland and crossing Liki North River and continue uphill to Mackinders Valley from where there are panoramic views up the valley towards the Shipton Camp. This camp is a surreal setting below the towering peaks and glacier. Resident population is of Rock hyrax and sun birds.

Day 3: Shipton - Pt Lenana (4985 m asl) to Mackinder's camp (4300 m asl) -Met Station camp (3050 m asl)

Wake up at 0200hrs for Tea and snacks then attempt the summit of point Lenana (4985 m asl).After a magical view of sunrise from the horizon at around 0600hrs at point Lenana, you descend to Mackinder's camp for breakfast and later descend to Meet station camp (11 KM) where you spend the night enjoying the fresh air of the serene environment deep in the Bamboo zone .After last dinner in mt Kenya you spend the night in the Banda's .



Day 4: Met Station (3050 m asl) -Naromoru Gate (2650 m asl) 10 KM

Wake up early at 0630hrs then pack all your trekking equipment and enjoy a delicious breakfast and later descend down from the camp to Naromoru National Park gate ready for pick up for Nairobi.

We also organize via other routes such as: Sirimon route, Sirimon- Chogoria route and Naromoru - Naromoru route

ZANZIBAR EXCURSIONS

OS 029 Jozani forest

Tourists can enjoy the view of the lush vegetation and can spot stunning Flora and Fauna on their walks through the park. It's mainly good for nature lovers.

OS 030 Stone Town Tour

- **Palace Museum** is a 3-story building with merlon-decorated white walls located in Mizingani Road, on the seafront, between the House of wonders and the Old Dispensary.

- **Old Dispensary** was once a dispensary and today stands as one of the most iconic landmarks in Stone Town, it is an architectural marvel that reflects a fusion of various cultures, as well as the island's rich trading history.

- **Old Fort** the oldest building located in stone town, the fort has been restored and transformed into a popular cultural center that showcases Swahili culture and promotes local tourism in the area.

- **Anglican Cathedral** also known as the Christ Church Cathedral, is a stunning and historically significant monument located in Stone Town. The cathedral has undergone extensive restoration and renovation over recent years and now includes an interactive museum detailing both its religious significance within the community and its historical context regarding Zanzibar's slave trading past.

- **House of Wonders** Its known to be the largest and tallest building of stone town built in 1883 for the second Sultan of Tanzania. It was intended as ceremonial palace and official reception hall, celebrating modernity and it was named "House of Wonders" because it was the first building to have electricity.



OS 031 Cheetah's Rock

Their goal is to rescue wild animals and contribute to conservation. They have three types of different tours which are:

The Great wildlife tour where by one can feel the Fur and breath of lions and many more, VIP Otter Experience where by you swim and play with their cute rescued otters and The Combined Tour where by you'll get to swim and play with the otters it's always a magical and memorable Full-day Adventure.

OS 032 Mnemba Island

It's a special Island because of its size and exclusivity, but most importantly because of the coral reef that surrounds it. The reef is called Mnemba Atoll. The Island is known as a Scuba diving site and also you might tend to find larger species such as turtles and dolphins. Calm conditions are most frequent in November and March with maximum visibility.




OS 033 Prison island

Also known as Changuu Island is an Island located in Zanzibar. It takes approximately 25min boat ride from stone town to the prison Island. It was once a detention center for slave. Today, the island is a popular tourist destination known for its pristine beaches and giant tortoises which can live up to 200 years. It's a perfect destination for adventure where you can take a dip in the clear waters surrounding Prison Island or go snorkeling to explore vibrant coral reefs teeming with marine life.

OS 034 Mangapwani Slave Caves

Mangapwani meaning Arab shore. The caves are believed to have been dug in the 19th century for the purpose of holding slaves before being shipped off to different parts of the world. The underground chambers provided an ideal location for traders because they were cool, inaccessible and therefore difficult for escapees to access. This history is now being preserved as a cultural heritage site which visitors can tour with certified guide services offering local insights on how business was conducted through the slave trade.

OS 035 Nairobi/ Masai Mara/ Serengeti/ Ngorongoro/ Arusha (5 Nights)

Day 1 Nairobi – Masa Mara

After breakfast pick up at your hotel and leave for Masai Mara, check in at hotel. Have lunch at the lodge/camp, freshen up and get ready for an afternoon game drive and sundowner. Dinner and overnight at the lodge/camp.

Day 2 Masai Mara

Full day spend in Masai Mara in search of the Big Five. Optional Hot air balloon can be arranged upon request at an extra cost. Meals and overnight at lodge.

Day 3 Masai Mara-Serengeti

After breakfast leave with packed lunch boxes to Serengeti via Isebania border, after clearing with immigration meet our Tanzania professional driver guide, change vehicles and proceed with your safari to Serengeti National Park Arrive with en route game drive to your lodge in the late evening. Dinner and Overnight at the camp/ lodge.

Day 4 Serengeti

Spend the whole day gaming in Serengeti in pursuit of spotting The Big five. Dinner and Overnight at the camp/ lodge in Serengeti.

Day 5 Serengeti- Ngorongoro

Leave Serengeti after breakfast for a full day at Ngorongoro crater which was once an active volcanic mountain. Dinner and overnight at Ngorongoro camp/lodge.

Day 6 Ngorongoro crater- Arusha

Depart for Arusha to catch flight back home.

OS 036 Nairobi/ Naivasha/ Nakuru/ Maasai Mara/ Serengeti/ Ngorongoro/ Amboseli/ Nairobi (13 nights)

Day 1 Nairobi

Arrival at JKIA airport in Nairobi, pick up by our able driver for transfer to the hotel in Nairobi. Briefing of the tour at the hotel lobby. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 2: Nairobi -Naivasha

After breakfast depart for Naivasha via the Nairobi -Mai Mahiu road and stop by at the view point in order to have a glimpse of the Great Rift Valley Scenic Escarpments. Later on, in the day proceed to Hell's Gate for a walk in the Park /cycling in the park and later visit Crescent Island for Horse riding and Bird watching as you have your lunch. Then drive to Nakuru for Overnight.

Day 3: Nakuru

After having breakfast, go for an early game drive at the L. Nakuru National, home to the black & white rhinos, Rothschild giraffe, baboons, beautiful flamingoes, white Pelicans among other animals. Lunch, dinner and overnight at the lodge inside the park.

Day 4: Nakuru -Maasai Mara

Depart for Maasai Mara early in the morning after breakfast, on arrival check in to your camp/ lodge, have lunch, enjoy the facilities as you familiarize with the camp/ lodge. Game drive in the afternoon, later retire to bed after dinner.

Day 5& 6 Maasai Mara

Spend another two full days with game viewing drive, other activities that can be included are:Maasai village visit for cultural experience, Hot air balloon ride over Masai Mara eco system. All meals and overnight at your lodge/ camp.

Day 7: Maasai Mara -Serengeti

After breakfast leave with packed lunch boxes to Serengeti via Isebania border, after clearing with immigration meet our Tanzania professional driver guide, change vehicles and proceed with your safari to Serengeti National Park Arrive with en route game drive to your lodge in the late evening. Dinner and Overnight at the camp/ lodge.

Day 8: Serengeti

Morning game drive whereby you will have time of birdwatching and spotting the big five. Serengeti is dense with varied wildlife. Millions of wildebeest and Zebras breeds in Serengeti then commence the migration to Masai Mara game reserve to look for pastures and water and also a bit safer place for giving birth. Dinner and overnight at the lodge/camp.

Day 9: Olduvai George -Ngorongoro

Leave Serengeti after breakfast to Ngorongoro Conservation area passing through Olduvai George museum to explore different types of cultural exhibits, fossils of early man and of animals. Dinner and overnight at Ngorongoro lodge/ camp.

Day 10 &11 Ngorongoro

Spend two full days in Ngorongoro Conservation area with game viewing drive. Ngorongoro crater is known for it was once among the tallest mountains before it erupted, for its dazzling beauty and being a paradise of animals, it is referred to as the Garden of Eden. Dinner and overnight at the lodge/camp.

Day 12: Ngorongoro- – Amboseli

After breakfast, drive to the Kenya/ Tanzania border town of Namanga where you will be assisted to clear with immigration and customs formalities. Meet our Kenyan driver guide, change vehicles and proceed to Amboseli arriving in time for lunch. Dinner and overnight at lodge.

Day 13: Amboseli

Leave early in the morning to spend the whole day having a game drive. All meals to be served at the lodge.

Day 14: Amboseli – Nairobi

Depart after breakfast for Nairobi where you'll catch your flight back home in the evening.



TANZANIA SAFARIS

OS 037 Arusha/ lake Manyara/ Ngorongoro/ Serengeti/ Arusha (5 Nights)

Day 1 Arusha

Arrival at airport. Picked by our representative for transfer to hotel. Checking in at hotel and tour briefing to take place at the hotel. Evening City tour of Arusha. Dinner and Overnight at Hotel.

Day 2 Arusha -L. Manyara

After breakfast we leave for Lake Manyara which is located in the Great rift valley. Here you'll get the opportunity to see some of the famous tree climbing lions. Have an afternoon game drive after lunch. Dinner and overnight at the lodge

Day 3 L. Manyara- Ngorongoro Crater

Early morning game drive at Lake Manyara get a spectacular view of the lake, see large herds of Elephant, Flamingos and many other Flora and Fauna. Have breakfast at hotel, at leisure enjoy the hotel facilities. Later in the afternoon leave for Ngorongoro crater. Dinner and Overnight at the lodge/ camp

Day 4 Ngorongoro Crater-Olduvai gorge- Serengeti

Have a morning game drive at the Ngorongoro conservation area after breakfast. You'll also get a chance to have a walk around the crater rim to get panoramic views of the Conservation area and the crater itself. Later on, in the afternoon leave for Serengeti National Park en route to Olduvai Gorge museum. Dinner and overnight at Serengeti lodge/ camp.

Day 5 Serengeti

Have an early morning game drive with an optional hot air balloon ride to get to experience Serengeti from the skies (at an extra cost), later on return at the hotel for a late morning breakfast. Spend leisure at the camp/lodge, also if interested you may also visit the visitor Centre. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 6 Serengeti- Arusha

After breakfast you leave for Arusha where you'll get to catch your flight back home.



OS 038 Arusha /Tarangire / Serengeti /Ngorongoro /Arusha (3 Nights)

Day 1: Arusha -Tarangire

After Breakfast, depart and drive across the Maasai steppe to Tarangire National Park. Proceed with a game drive, lunch the lodge and later have an afternoon game drive until late. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 2: Tarangire- Serengeti


After breakfast leave for Serengeti with packed lunch boxes, game drive in the endless plains of the Serengeti for a chance to see the great herds of wildebeest, zebras and gazelles or a pride of lions lounging in the shade. Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

Day 3: Serengeti- Ngorongoro

Have a morning game drive at Serengeti, leave with packed lunch boxes to Ngorongoro crater, the largest collapsed volcanic crater in the world and about fourteen kilometers of isolated natural beauty. After picnic lunch, proceed with an afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight at the camp/ lodge.

Day 4: Ngorongoro- Arusha

After breakfast depart for Arusha with en route game drive to catch your evening flight.



MT. KILIMANJARO

OS 039 Machame route (6 Days)

The Machame route, also known as the Whisky Route is one of the most scenic and recommended routes on Kilimanjaro. This popular route with paths through magnificent forests to gain a ridge leading through the moorland zones to the Shira Plateau. It then traverses beneath the glaciated precipices of the Southern Ice fields to join the Barafu Route to the summit. Because it can be done over longer periods and the incline is more manageable it has a much higher success rate of summit.

Duration: 6 or 7 days

Difficulty: Medium

Scenery: Excellent

Traffic: High

Day 1: Machame Gate – Machame Camp: 10.75k /7mi | 5-6 hrs. | Rainforest

Elevation: 1811m/5942ft to 3021m/9911ft

Altitude gained: 1210m

Departing from Moshi a 45-minute drive will take you through the Village of Machame to the Kilimanjaro National Park Gate. We will patiently wait for our permits to be issued while watching the hustle and bustle of operations as many crews prepare for the journey ahead. Enjoy the beautiful rainforest scenery and windy trails while your guide tells you about the local flora and fauna and natural wildlife. At these lower elevations, the trail can be muddy and quite slippery. We highly recommend gaiters and trekking poles here.

Day 2: Machame Camp – Shira Camp: 5.3km/3mi | 4-5hrs | Moorland

Elevation: 3021m/9911ft to 3839m/12,595ft

Altitude gained: 818m

After a hearty breakfast we emerge from the rain forest and continue on an ascending path, crossing the valley along a steep rocky ridge. The route now turns west onto a river gorge until we arrive at the Shira campsite. Temperatures begin to drop.

Day 3: Shira Camp – Lava Tower – Barranco Camp: 10.75km/6mi | 5-6hrs | Semi-Desert

Elevation: 3839m/12,595ft to 3986m/13,077ft

Altitude gained: 147m

Although you end the day around the same elevation as when you began, this day is very important for acclimatization. From Shira Plateau we continue east up a ridge, passing the junction towards the Kibo peak before we then continue, South East towards the Lava Tower, called the “Shark’s Tooth” (elev. 4650m/15,250ft). Shortly after the tower, we come to a second junction, which leads to the Arrow Glacier. We then continue to descend to overnight at Barranco Camp.

Day 4: Barranco Camp (3986 M Asl)– Barafu Camp (4662 M Asl): 8.5km | 6-7hrs | Alpine Desert

After breakfast, we continue on a steep ridge up to the adventurous Barranco Wall to the Karanga Valley and the junction, which connects, with the Mweka Trail. This is one of the most impressive days to see the power, agility, and strength of your crew zip over this wall with what appears such ease via Karanga camp(4034 m als)

We continue up toward Barafu Camp, and once reached you have now completed the South Circuit, which offers a variety of breathtaking views of the summit from many different angles. An early dinner and rest as we prepare for summit night. Overnight at Barafu Camp.

Day 5: Barafu Camp – Summit: 4.86km /3mi Up | 5-7hrs | – Mweka Camp: 11.5km /7.2mi Down | 5-6hrs | Glaciers, Snow Capped Summit

Elevation: 4662m/15,295ft to 5895m/19,341ft

Altitude gained: 1233m

Descent to 3106m/10,190ft

Altitude lost: 2789m

Excitement is building as morning comes with an early start between midnight and 2 a.m. This is the most mentally and physically challenging portion of the trek.

We continue our way to the summit between the Rebmann and Ratzel glaciers trying to stay warm and focused on the amazing sense of accomplishment that lies ahead. With a switchback motion in a northwesterly direction and ascend through heavy scree towards Stella Point on the crater rim. You will be rewarded with the most magnificent sunrise during your short rest here. Faster hikers may view the sunrise from the summit. From here on your remaining 1-hour ascent to Uhuru Peak, you are likely to encounter snow all the way.

Congratulations, one step at a time you have now reached Uhuru Peak the highest point on Mount Kilimanjaro and the entire continent of Africa!

After photos, celebrations and maybe a few tears of joy we take a few moments to enjoy this incredible accomplishment. We begin our steep descent down to Mweka Camp, stopping at Barafu for lunch and a very brief rest. We strongly recommend gaiters and trekking poles for uncooperative loose gravel and volcano ash terrain. Well-deserved rest awaits you to enjoy your last evening on the mountain. Overnight Mweka Camp.

Day 6: Mweka Camp – Mweka Gate – Moshi: 9.1km/6mi |3-4hrs | Rainforest

Elevation: 3106m/10,190ft to 1633m/5358ft

Altitude lost: 1473m

After breakfast and a heartfelt ceremony of appreciation and team bonding with your crew, it's time to say goodbye. We continue the descent down to the Mweka Park Gate to receive your summit certificates. As the weather is drastically warmer, the terrain is wet, muddy and steep and we highly recommend Gaiters and trekking poles. From the gate, a vehicle will meet you at Mweka village to drive you back to your hotel. Enjoy a long overdue hot shower, dinner and celebrations

We also organize via other routes which include: Marangu Route (Coca- Cola) and Lemosho Route



Uganda Trips



OS 040 Gorilla trekking (2 nights)

Departs daily on request

Day 1 Entebbe/Kampala- Bwindi National Park


Depart Entebbe/Kampala in the morning at around 0700hrs for a journey Southwest to Bwindi National Park, home to half of the world's population of the endangered Silverback Mountain Gorillas with en route stopover at the equator for photography and lunch break in Mbarara. You will proceed to Bwindi National Park reaching early in the evening. Dinner and overnight stay at the camp/lodge.

Day 2 Bwindi National Park

After an early morning breakfast, walk to the park headquarters for briefing on the dos and don'ts during this activity and thereafter you will proceed to the gorilla trail. Gorilla tracking normally lasts between 2 to 8 hours or even a day to encounter the gorillas. Depending on when you find your "group" gorillas, you will enjoy a picnic lunch before trek back to camp. Dinner and overnight at the camp/Lodge.

Day 3 Bwindi - Entebbe

After breakfast, start your journey back to Entebbe with lunch en route.



OS 041 Murchison falls National Park, Kibale National Park, Queen Elizabeth National Park and Bwindi Impenetrable National Park by Road (6 nights)

Departs daily on request

Day 1 Kampala/Entebbe -Murchison Falls National Park

After breakfast the safari begins through the famous Luwero triangle with a stop over at Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary to experience life with the Rhinos. After tracking the rhinos, proceed with the journey having another stopover in Masindi for lunch, after lunch head to Murchison Falls National Park and upon arrival you'll check in at the lodge/camp and relax. Dinner and overnight at the lodge /camp.

Day 2 Murchison Falls National Park

After breakfast, begin exploring the park with a game drive in the northern circuit of the park. There, you will encounter beautiful rolling plains. While in these plains you may view Lions, Giraffes, Buffalos, Elephants, Antelopes, Hippos, Spotted hyenas, Wild cat, lion, leopard as well as many of the other mammals of the park. For the birders, this area supports the Secretary Bird, Black-chested Snake Eagle, Tawny and Martial Eagles Carmine and Swallow-tailed Bee-Eaters among others.

After lunch, you will go for a boat trip to the bottom of Murchison Falls where the Nile thunders through a small 7-meter gap down to the delta. Thereafter, undertake a hiking expedition to the top of the falls. While hiking, you will enjoy sighting this marvelous fall from different angles and it's from the top where you will enjoy seeing the Nile River forcing its way through the narrow gorge. Dinner and overnight at the lodge /camp.

Day 3 Murchison Falls National Park- Kibale National Park

After breakfast depart for a journey South to Fort Portal via Hoima. This is a long drive which takes about 8 hours.

While on the journey, you may opt for occasional stopovers to enjoy views of beautiful sceneries like the Rift valley escarpment on Lake Albert. Also, this travel gives you an opportunity to have an insight about the typical African village setup in the far countryside and various plantations. On arrival you'll check in at the lodge/camp and relax. Dinner and overnight at the lodge /camp.

Day 4 Kibale National Park & Queen Elizabeth National Park

After breakfast, we move to the forest for primates viewing, before the activity starts you will be briefed by a park ranger. The activity starts early in the morning at 0800hrs. A half day search of Chimpanzees and monkeys. You will also see varieties of birds, butterflies and many small insects.

After a successful track of these primates, you will leave for Queen Elizabeth National Park and along the way; you will enjoy the spectacular views of the splendid Rwenzori ranges. Upon arrival you'll check in at the lodge/camp and relax. Dinner and overnight at the lodge /camp.

Day 5 Queen Elizabeth National Park- Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

Begins with a morning game drive in Queen Elizabeth national Game Park exploring the area of Kasenyi plains. You will see various animals such as Elephants, Buffaloes, Antelopes and various birds. The rewarding four-hour drive brings us to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park in the evening. Dinner and overnight at the lodge /camp.

Day 6 Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

Early morning, you will go gorilla trekking. This amazing activity takes you through the densely forested steep hills until you finally meet these tranquil gorillas within the green plant cover. It is such a wonderful yet memorable encounter. The canopy will envelop you completely with rare and exotic flora found on every side. This is a challenging trek since it involves hiking through steep ascents and tangled trails.


Once gorillas are identified, you will be allowed a maximum time of one hour within their vicinity and then after walk out of the dense forest. Your time with the gorillas will certainly create a long-lasting memory about your visit to Uganda.

In the evening, you will have a cultural visit to interact with the local people. Participate in cultivating traditional performances presented by women's groups. Dinner and overnight at the lodge /camp.

Day 7 Bwindi Impenetrable National Park- Entebbe/Kampala

After breakfast, embark on a journey back to Kampala, visiting Igongo cultural village en route. Here we learn about the Bahima and Ankole cultures of Uganda, glimpsing the history of these interesting people. We cross the Equator stopping to take photos and to have lunch along the way.

We arrive in Kampala or Entebbe in time to catch the evening flight.
